# OFFICIAL LITTLE MISS ST. PATRICK'S DAY PAGEANT RULES

Clear Channel Radio Savannah - 97.3 KISSFM/WAEV & Coastal Pageant Productions, known as "The Company" will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

## Description of Contest/Participation

- A. **Dates of Contest:** Application registration dates January 8, 2012 – March 2, 2012. All applications and entry fees must be postmarked no later than February 24, 2012 if paying by personal check. PERSONAL CHECKS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY FEBRUARY 24th. AFTER FEBRUARY 24<sup>TH</sup>, ONLY PAYPAL, CASHIER'S CHECK OR MONEY ORDER WILL BE ACCEPTED until March 2nd. Day of pageant registration is available from 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. for all age divisions. After March 2nd or on day of pageant, late fee is \$25. Only Money Order, Cashier's Check or Cash will be accepted day of the pageant. No entries will be accepted after 9:30 a.m. for all age divisions. The pageant will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday March 10, 2012.
- B. **Check-In:** Each contestant must check-in between 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. on pageant day to be eligible to compete.
- C. **Entry fees are as follows:** Beauty \$80 (required). Best Hair, Eyes, Dress, Smile, & Personality are FREE. Photogenic (optional) is \$15.
- D. **Who can enter?** Any girl between the ages of 0-13 years. AGE ON PAGEANT DAY DETERMINES AGE DIVISION
- E. **How to enter?** Submit an application and fee according to the timeline above. No Refunds given for any reasons.
- F. **Photos:** All photogenic pictures must be dropped off by 9:30 a.m. for all age divisions at the registration table.
- G. **Decisions:** We will have a winner in each age group. If your child was a past age winner, you may still enter the pageant. Judges decisions are final and scores will not be released. There will be 2 overall Supreme winners announced, one from the 0-4 yr. age group and from the 5-13 yr. age group, and will ride in the parade.
- H. **Double Crowning:** A contestant can win her age division and still be crowned the Overall or Supreme Winner.
- I. **People's Choice:** Ask for people or businesses to vote for your little one to be "The People's Choice!" You may vote as many times as you like. 1 vote = \$1! Anyone can vote. Cash or check is accepted. Make the checks payable to Coastal Pageant Productions. Collect and turn in at registration the morning of the pageant. They can even vote that morning! The **one** highest vote-getter will receive a crown and banner and ride in the parade.
- J. **Photogenic judging:** Photos must be no larger than 8x10, color or black & white, headshots. All photos must be turned in at registration and picked up at the end of the pageant. We are not responsible for photos not picked up.
- K. **Judging process:** Attire should be an age appropriate pageant dress. Judges will be judging on facial beauty, attire & overall look, poise & personality. Modeling limit on stage will be one minute. Hair & make-up will be at the parent's personal preference. Hair pieces & glitz are acceptable. Make your child look her most beautiful.
- L. **Dressing Rooms:** Dressing room area will be held in the cafeteria. There is NO covered walkway between the cafeteria and backstage. Contestants should come prepared for any type of weather, including wind, drizzle, and rain. Come prepared for anything. Hairdressers and make-up artists are allowed in the dressing room with the contestant. **NO MALES** are allowed in the dressing area. A pageant official will be in the room to call when your age group is ready to line up and be escorted from the dressing room to the backstage area. Please make sure to stay in the dressing room area, if a contestant is not in the dressing room during her line up, we will not be held responsible.
- M. **Backstage:** There will be one person allowed backstage with a contestant, should they need assistance. If a child prefers her father to walk with her onstage, he will be allowed backstage. Please remember that space backstage is limited, so we only have room for one person per contestant.

**Prizes-** Each girl wins a trophy. Any unsportsmanlike conduct from the contestant, family, or friends will result in disqualification! If a winner is disqualified, the Company reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize in its sole discretion. Age group winners receive a crown, trophy, & banner.

**Publicity & Privacy-** By participating, all participants and winner(s) grant the Company exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Contest, participants agree that the Company may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

**Release-** By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Company, its employees and agents, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. In order to receive a prize, participants must sign an official waiver form provided by the Company.

**Taxes-** Any valuation of the prize(s) stated above is based on available information provided to the Company, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Each winner is solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes. Each winner must provide the Company with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before any prize will be awarded. Prizes are not transferable, redeemable for cash or exchangeable for any other prize. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from a station will receive an IRS form 1099 at the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS.

The Company reserves the right to disqualify any participant or winner and may refuse to award any prize to a person who is ineligible or has violated any rule, gained unfair advantage in participating in the Contest, or obtained winner status using fraudulent means. The Company will interpret these rules and resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest and the Company's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final. If the conduct or outcome of the Contest is affected by human error, any mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Company, the Company reserves the right to terminate this Contest, or make such other decisions regarding the outcome as the Company deems appropriate. All decisions will be made by the Company and are final. The Company may waive any of these rules in its sole discretion.

**Miscellaneous-** Official rules subject to change. Each winner must submit proof of eligibility and sign the Company's release form to claim the prize. No purchase necessary to participate or win. ## 2011 Little Miss St. Patrick's Day Pageant- Frequently Asked Questions

**Who can compete?** Any girl between the age of 0-13 (going by their birth date on the day of the pageant)

**Entry fee:** \$80 \$15 Photogenic \$5 (each additional photo submitted) No refunds.

**Who will ride in the parade?** The contestant with the highest score in the 0-4 year age group and the contestant with the highest score in the 5-13 year age group will be the 2 supreme winners that will ride in the parade with the People's Choice overall winner.

**Can a contestant win her age group and be crowned the Supreme winner?** Yes, we will allow double crowning in this pageant.

**How do you win People's Choice?** Solicit votes from your friends and family. Voting is open until the last contestant is finished in that contestant's age group and the emcee has announced the close of that group. Votes are tallied. The overall highest vote-getter from all of the Little Miss age divisions is announced and that **one** girl will ride in the parade. If the winner of the overall beauty portion of the pageant is also the People's Choice winner, then we award the People's Choice winner to the next highest vote-getter.

**Who judges and what do they look for?** We select experienced judges who either have competed in pageants, directed pageants or have had experienced children compete in pageants. The judges are looking for a beautiful face followed by a good overall appearance in terms of their hair, make-up, dress and accessories. Make your child look her personal best. Modeling and personality will also be considered. This pageant takes place on a stage with full stage lighting. Make-up is appropriate for this pageant. We use a basic T formation. Judges will be in the center of the first rows. You may go out on the stage prior to the pageant start time.

**Who is in the pageant?** Any girl from anywhere may enter. Experienced and first timers welcome!

**What does each contestant compete in?** Contestants compete in beauty only. Each age group comes out in group line-up where the judges will decide the optional awards such as prettiest eyes and dress. Contestants come on stage individually after group line-up.

**What time does check-in begin?** ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK-IN BETWEEN 8:30-9:30 A.M. This is for ALL age divisions. Check-in will close promptly at 9:30 a.m.! Check-in will take place in the lobby of the auditorium. The pageant will begin at 10 a.m.

**Do you offer a Sister Discount?** Yes, we offer a sister discount of \$20.00 to the second and third sisters.

**What does "Glitz" mean?** Glitz is a pageant term that generally means the dresses are loaded with rhinestones or sequins and the contestant generally uses make-up, eyelashes, hair pieces etc. to dramatically enhance a child's appearance and beauty. Glitz is acceptable. The internet is a good source for tips and tricks of the trade in making your child there most beautiful with stage lighting.

**Where are the dressing rooms?** The cafeteria on campus at Savannah Country Day School will serve as the dressing room again this year. The cafeteria is the building directly to the left of the auditorium. Please understand that there is NO covered walkway from the cafeteria to the auditorium. This means you will need to be prepared to walk outside, regardless of the weather. Please come prepared should there be wind, drizzle, or even rain. You are encouraged to bring a mirror, power strip, etc. to the cafeteria as you set up. The dressing area will open at 8:00 a.m. on pageant day. Please do not arrive expecting to have access to the dressing area before 8:00 a.m.

**Are Make-up artists and hairdressers allowed in the dressing room?** Yes! Because of our increased size of the dressing area, you are allowed to have people with you! As always, no men are allowed in the dressing room. It can get very warm so dress appropriately.

**What is the difference between "registering" and "checking-in?"** Registering and paying by check is done prior to February 24th. Registering and paying with a cashier's check or money order can be done, but they must be postmarked no later than Friday March 2 to avoid the late fee. Late registration which has a \$25 late fee is between 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. on the morning of the pageant. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK-IN so they can receive their number, turn in their photogenic pictures and receive pageant information.

**What is the admission fee?** Admission fee is \$7 for adults and \$4 for 4-12 year olds. Children under 3 will be admitted for free.

**Do you have a photographer or videographer?** KISSFM staff will attempt to photograph each girl as they compete and post the photos for free downloads at [973kissfm.com](http://973kissfm.com). If one is present then no photographs or videos will be allowed.

**Do we have a rehearsal?** No, we do not have a rehearsal prior to the pageant. DO NOT contact the school prior to the pageant.

**How do I pay?** Personal checks are accepted BEFORE FEBRUARY 24th. After February 24<sup>th</sup> only Paypal, Cashier's Check and Money Orders are via mail with a postmarked date no later than Friday March 2. Cash, Money Order, or Cashier's Check will only be accepted at the pageant. Return check fee is \$35. Pay Pal customers should submit a LEGIBLE email address for the invoice.

**When should I arrive?** Plan to arrive at 8:30. There is no need to arrive prior to then. Dressing rooms will not open prior to 8 am!

**When do I receive my contestant number?** You will receive your number and placement at check-in the day of the pageant.

**When do I bring my photogenic picture?** Bring your photo with you to check-in the day of the pageant. Photogenic will be judged 30 minutes prior to the pageant. Late photos will not be judged in photogenic. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN!

**How do you determine contestant order?** The first to enter will be the last to compete. Those registering the day of the pageant and paying the late fee will be added to the end of the contestant order.
